Project Description:

The District is in the process of obtaining a State Water Resources Control Board Clean Water State Revolving Fund Grant to replace the wastewater system at the Jenny Lind Elementary School (JLES). The Project will require work on the JLES site as well as off-site. Off-site improvements include installation of a pipeline from JLES to the existing CCWD gravity sewer located at the west end of Vista Del Lago Drive West. The Project will also include replacement of +/- 870 linear foot of pipeline that bisects the La Contenta Plaza back parking area, traverses several residential lots and terminates on the La Contenta Golf Club property.

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF  
CALAVERAS UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT  
ADOPTING AN INITIAL STUDY/MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION  
FOR THE  
JENNY LIND ELEMENTARY SCHOOL  
WASTEWATER REGIONALIZATION PROJECT**

**WHEREAS** the Calaveras Unified School District (District) has proposed to regionalize with Calaveras County Water District (CCWD). The regionalization project will require off-site improvements including installation of a pipeline from the school to the existing CCWD gravity sewer main located at the west end of Vista Del Lago Drive West. The project will also include replacement of ± 870 linear foot of pipeline that bisects the La Contenta Plaza back parking area, traverses several residential lots and terminates on the La Contenta Golf Club property;

**WHEREAS** approval of the District's Proposal is considered a project for purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) found in Public Resources Code 21000 et seq;

**WHEREAS**, the District prepared a Draft Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration dated February 2019, which reflected the independent judgment of the District as to the potential environmental impacts of the Project;

**WHEREAS**, the Draft Initial Study/Negative Declaration was circulated (State Clearinghouse # 2019029121) for the required 30 days for public review and comment from February 21, 2019 to March 23, 2019, and a public notice was published in the Calaveras Enterprise on February 21, 2019;

**WHEREAS**, comment letters were received from no members of the public and from three public agencies;

**WHEREAS**, on April 9, 2019 the District held a properly noticed public hearing to receive comments on the Draft Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration at which time all interested parties had the opportunity to be heard and comments considered; and


**WHEREAS**, on April 9, 2019, the District Board of Trustees considered the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration and all written and oral testimony submitted at the public hearing, and the District then adopted a motion of intent by voice vote to adopt the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration and to approve the Project.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Trustees of the Calaveras Unified School District hereby adopts the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration, as well as the associated Mitigated Monitoring and Reporting Program for the Jenny Lind Elementary School Wastewater Regionalization Project based upon the following findings:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and made a part of this resolution;
2. The Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Project was completed in full compliance with CEQA and CEQA Guidelines;
3. The Board of Trustees finds that on the basis of the whole record before it, including the initial study and the comments received, that there is no substantial evidence that the project will have a significant effect on the environment, and that the mitigated negative declaration represents the District's independent judgement and analysis;
4. The whole of the record of proceedings upon which the decision made by the Board of Trustees is available with the District Board Secretary at the District offices; and
5. The Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration and associated Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program for the Project was presented to the Board of Trustees who reviewed and considered the information contained therein prior to approving the proposed Project.


