This Notice of Decision is to advise you that the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Los Angeles Water Board) has determined that the above-referenced project has been approved. On December 8, 2016, the Regional Board adopted an amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan for the Los Angeles Region (Basin Plan) to incorporate stakeholder-developed groundwater quality management measures for salts and nutrients in the Main San Gabriel Basin of Los Angeles County (see attached Resolution No. R16-010). The Basin Plan amendment was subsequently approved by the State Water Resources Control Board on May 16, 2017 (SWRCB Resolution No. 2017-0030), and the Office of Administrative Law on December 13, 2018 (OAL File No. 2018-1030-04).


The Los Angeles Water Board has made the following determinations regarding the above-described project:

1. The groundwater quality management measures will have a less than significant effect on the environment - with mitigation incorporated.
2. Substitute environmental documents (SED) were prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA. The substitute documents include the Basin Plan Amendment, the Staff Memo, and Substitute Environmental Document.
3. Mitigation measures were analyzed in compliance with Public Resources Code section 21159.
4. Findings were made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
