The CHP Santa Fe Springs Area Office Replacement Project is part of a statewide effort to replace aging or inadequate CHP field offices and other facilities. The purpose of the Proposed Project is to relocate the Santa Fe Springs Area Office and replace it with new facilities that will provide adequate workspace, vehicle, and equipment storage for an increasing number of employees assigned to this office (approximately 13 new employees for a total of approximately 159 future employees). The Proposed Project would consist of construction and operation of buildings and other structures, auto service bays, an 120-foot tall radio antenna tower, secured and visitor parking areas, equipment enclosures and storage areas, a fuel island with gas tanks, an emergency generator, utility improvements, and other ancillary improvements.
