

PROJECT TITLE: Olompali Visitor Center Drainage

LOCATION: Olompali State Historic Park

COUNTY: Marin

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Improve the drainage system behind the Visitor Center at Olompali State Historic Park to protect the historic building from flooding during storms. Work will:

- Hand dig at the drain spouts and inlet to uncover the old drainage system. If one exists, rehabilitate and upgrade the existing drainage; or
- If none exists, then hand excavate a new 12" deep by 8" wide by approx. 50' long trench and install a new French drain consisting of fabric, drain rock, and a 4" perforated drain pipe.
