PROJECT TITLE: Park Residence Waterline Replacement (CRSP 206)

LOCATION: Cuyamaca Rancho State Park

COUNTY: San Diego

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Project will replace the water line from the meter to the residence for approximately 350 feet with schedule 80 PVC pipe. A trench will be dug approximately 2 feet wide and 3 feet deep in the driveway beside the existing waterline that runs on the edge of the driveway. It will branch off to a new fire Wharf head and get connected to the existing pipe at the residence. There will be 2 new shut off valves installed on the water line: One to the Wharf head and one to the house. Water detectable tape and tracer wire will be placed in the trench so the water line can be found if digging occurs in the area. The trench will be back filled with clean compaction sand to cover the new pipe for protection. The trench will then be back filled and compacted with the dirt that was dug out. The remaining dirt will be spread and re-contoured to match the existing grade and slope of the driveway. Once the grading is complete a new layer of road base will be added to blend the area back into the drive way.
