PROJECT TITLE: Stairs from Morro Bay Natural History Museum to Windy Cove

LOCATION: Morro Bay State Park

**COUNTY:** San Luis Obispo County

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** Install a series of interlocking trail steps and extend a drain culvert at Morro Bay State Park to repair a badly eroded trail leading from the Morro Bay Natural History Museum to the beach cove. Work will:

- Excavate up to 2 cubic yards of soil and duff and place approximately 250' of pressure treated 4" x 8" wood to form interlocking step walls and risers;
- Use 75 pieces of 3' long, 5/8" diameter rebar to secure the interlocking wood step walls and risers;
- Use 1" drain rock to backfill the lumber framed steps and cap with a compacted red-rock base; and
- Use 18", corrugated, plastic, culvert pipe to extend the existing culvert by approximately 40'.
