Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The proposed project involves the construction of a parallel pipeline to the existing pipeline and new manholes. in existing streets. The proposed project would construct a 15-inch-diameter PVC pipe and 18-inch HDPE pipe along W Crowther Avenue, an 18-inch-diameter PVC pipe and 20-inch HDPE pipe along S Placentia Avenue, and an 18-inch-diameter PVC pipe along E Orangethorpe Avenue and S State College Boulevard, totaling 7,530 linear feet in length. Upon completion of the proposed project, the existing 7,300 linear feet of 10-inch and 12-inch pipeline would be abandoned in place. Each end of the sewer pipeline between manholes would be plugged and capped. The new collection system would be reconnected to all service laterals and mainline connections.

The proposed project would result in potentially significant impacts related to Biological Resources, Cultural Resources, Geology and Soils, Noise, Transportation, and Tribal Cultural Resources.
