PROJECT DESCRIPTION: This is a request for the Planning Commission to evaluate the JVR Energy Park Project which consists of a Major Use Permit and Fire Protection and Mitigation Agreement for the construction, operation, maintenance, and ultimately the decommissioning of a solar energy facility with on-site battery storage for the production of 90 megawatts of electric power to be delivered to an existing San Diego Gas & Electric transmission line. The project will include photovoltaic modules mounted on support structures, inverter/transformer platforms, an on-site substation, an overhead transmission line and a battery energy storage system. The project will also include internal access, site access driveways, perimeter fencing, low-level shielded lighting, fuel modification zones, six water tanks for fire protection, and associated site infrastructure to support the solar energy generation and storage facility. Grading is expected to be balanced on site, with approximately 280,000 cubic yards of cut redistributed across the site. Access to the Project site is provided by Old Highway 80 and Carrizo Gorge Road. The Project site consists of 24 parcels and includes right-of-way easements for Old Highway 80, SDG&E easements, and an easement for the San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway. The project site is subject to the Village General Plan Regional Category for the majority of the 1,356-acre site area. The Project development footprint will be located primarily on land designated as Specific Plan Area. The proposed uses are consistent with the Zoning and General Plan Land Use Designation of the property established by the General Plan.

The Planning Commission will recommend to the Board of Supervisors whether to approve or deny the MUP and Fire Services and Mitigation Agreement, and whether to adopt the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) in accordance with CEQA.

LOCATION: Carrizo Gorge Road, South of Interstate 8, within the Jacumba Subregional Group Area of the Mountain Empire Subregional Plan Area. ENVIRONMENTAL STATUS: The project has been reviewed in compliance with CEQA. An Environmental Impact Report was prepared for the project and was available for public review from October 8, 2020, through December 7, 2020 (59 days).

Rules of the Hearing Body may limit or impose requirements upon the submittal of such written correspondence.

Here are the ways you can share your opinions!

Submit an eComment

To voice your opinion for upcoming Planning Commission meeting agenda items, use the eComment service. You can start submitting eComments when the agenda is released, typically 10 days before the hearing. The eComments are sent to the Planning Commissioners and the Director of Planning & Development Services for their review.

Public communication eComments for non-agenda items will be read into the record at the Planning Commission Meeting. Public comments on agenda items will be available to view online after the meeting and the number of comments received on each agenda item will be stated during the meeting. All eComments will be entered into the administrative record of the meeting.

Step 2: To provide testimony on an agenda item over the phone, please call (619) 343-2539 and enter the conference ID associated with the item you would like to speak on. This ID can be found below. Step 3: You will be placed on hold until it is your turn to speak. Mute your TV or computer to avoid feedback. Step 4: Listen closely for instructions and when called upon to speak, state your name and begin your comments.
