Project Title: Sacramento River Salmonid Stranding Reduction and Floodplain Habitat Restoration at Willow Bend Preserve (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0217-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project site is located adjacent to the Sacramento River off of Gould Road in the County of Colusa, State of California, Latitude 39.350811, Longitude -122.012325, Sections 6 and 2, Township 17N, Ranges 1W and 2W of the Mt. Diablo Meridian, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5-minute quadrangle map Moulton Weir.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0217-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, John Carlon/River Partners.

The project proposes to enhance floodplain and fish habitat adjacent to the Sacramento River by planting native vegetation, manipulating the existing topography, re-contouring a swale, modifying existing rock revetment, and installing a surface water control structure. The project includes maintenance for native vegetation plantings and the control of non-native invasive weeds for a three-year period.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 3/3/2021 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
