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Project Title: Oceano Dunes State Vehicular Recreation Area - Le Sage Fence Replacement

Project Location – Specific: Oceano Dunes SVRA

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: The purpose of this project is to remove and replace fencing within the SVRA property boundary. The fence is in disarray from the coastal marine environment. According to records, this fence is 30 plus years old. Vegetation will be the biggest challenge due to the landscape and years of growth along Meadow Creek. This project is very close in proximity to the Le Sage Rivera Trailer Park. The improvements will assist in security for the trailer park residences. Approximately 4,461 feet of perimeter fence and posts will be removed and replaced with a vinyl coated chain link fence approximately 5-6 feet high. Approximately 476 feet of security fence and posts will be removed and replaced with an 8-foot high security fence. Before the fence can be removed, up to three feet of vegetation clearance may be needed on both sides of the existing fence in order to allow a bobcat tractor and fence crews to remove and install the new fence. Most of the vegetation is non-native with the exception of a willow tree. Vegetation removal will be done with hand tools or the tractor if the vegetation is too thick. The tractor will be used to remove the old fence posts and boards. Silt fencing and/or straw wattles will be installed to reduce sediment runoff while work is being conducted. Native vegetation will be planted in the disturbed area.
