Title: CONSIDER FINDING OF DEFAULT; AUTHORIZATION TO TERMINATE A GENERAL LEASE – COMMERCIAL USE AND ACCEPTANCE OF A LEASE QUITCLAIM DEED; AND AUTHORIZATION TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY, INCLUDING LITIGATION, TO REMOVE IMPROVEMENTS AND RESTORE THE LEASE PREMISES – PRC 6200.1

Location: A 0.43-acre parcel, more or less, of sovereign land in the Sacramento River, adjacent to 14031 River Road (Highway 160), Walnut Grove, Sacramento County.

Description: Authorize the Executive Officer, or her designee, in cooperation with the Office of the Attorney General, to take all necessary and appropriate steps, including litigation, to enforce the termination of Lease No. PRC 6200.1 against the Lessee and any agents, affiliates, successors, or assigns; to access the lease premises to ensure the health and safety of the people of California and the surrounding environment; to eject trespassers that occupy lease premises; to remove improvements from the lease premises; to restore the sovereign land at this location to the satisfaction of the Executive Officer, or her designee; and to recover the Commission's damages and costs.


