Project Location (include county): The project to be completed is located within the Blue Slide Creek watershed, approximately 1.92 miles southeast of the town of Ettersburg, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 9, T4S, R2E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Ettersburg U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 221-221-016; latitude 40.1307 N and longitude 123.9604 W at the parcel center.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0821-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Mr. William Paulsin.

The project is limited to three encroachments to Blue Slide Creek (Table 1). One encroachment is for water diversion for domestic use. Work for the water diversion will include installation, use, and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The other encroachments are to remediate unpermitted riparian tree removal. Work for these encroachments may include riparian tree planting, caging, maintenance, and monitoring.
