Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

The proposed project consists of facility improvements to the existing Watsonville Facility building such as the ADA compliant unisex restroom with a shower and a washer/dryer room, exterior upgrades to existing parking and the design of new ADA parking stalls and accessibility upgrades to the path of travel. There will also be modifications to power, lighting and HVAC to suit the new spaces.

The exterior parking upgrades include bollard and card reader installation of up to 6" deep, slurry seal AC pavement improvements, concrete installation of up to 12" deep and incorporation of accessibility signage that may go up to 3" deep into the ground.
