Caltrans proposes to have a geotechnical investigation completed to support the design of the culvert repair on State Route (SR) 101 at PM 41.41, Ritner Creek. The culvert at this location is failing and needs to be replaced and will likely require a replacement strategy that is compatible for fish passage. Four borings are proposed at this location. The upper portion of all the borings proposed are located within existing fills and will be drilled from the existing highway surface. The purpose of the geotechnical drilling is to assess the engineering properties of the subsurface materials for foundation design purposes. The subsurface data will be summarized, interpreted, used in project design and provided in a Geotechnical Report to be included in the plans. All work will be in the existing State right of way.




