Each project applicant shall remit to the county clerk the environmental filing fee before or at the time of filing a Notice of Determination (Pub. Resources Code, § 21152; Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subdivision (d); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 753.5). Without the appropriate fee, statutory or categorical exemption, or a valid No Effect Determination issued by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW), the Notice of Determination is not operative, vested, or final, and shall not be accepted by the county clerk.

#### COUNTY DOCUMENTARY HANDLING FEE

The county clerk may charge a documentary handling fee of fifty dollars (\$50) per filing in addition to the environmental filing fee (Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subd. (e); Cal. # **Project Description**

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to construct improvements on US Route 101 between post miles 77.3 and 78.1 in Humboldt County in the City of Eureka for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Work would include replacing curb ramps, sidewalks, and driveways. The project would also improve drainage and the install audible pedestrian signals at existing signalized intersections.

## Determination

Caltrans has prepared an Initial Study for this project and, following public review, has determined from this study that the proposed project would not have a significant impact on the environment for the following reasons:
