The project limits on I-5 extend from approximately 0.1 mile south of Los Alisos Boulevard Overcrossing (Post Mile [PM] 17.8) to 0.4 mile north of Ridge Route Drive (PM 19.7), and on El Toro Road from Rockfield Boulevard to Paseo De Valencia, a distance of approximately 1.9 miles.
