Project Location (include county): The activities authorized by this Agreement are located within Hamilton Slough and Sutter Butte Canal, in the County of Butte, State of California; in Township 18N, Range 3E, Sections 7; United States Geological Survey (USGS) Biggs 7.5 minute quadrangle map, Mt. Diablo base and meridian.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0359-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Butte County Department of Public Works.

The Project will replace the East Rio Bonito Road over Hamilton Slough and Sutter Butte Canal Bridges as well as the associated roadway infrastructure.
