**SUBJECT: Filing of Notice of Determination pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21108**

Project Title: Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0034-R2 "Bacchi" THP 4-18-009-ELD

Project Location: These projects are located within El Dorado County in the Greenwood Creek and Kelsey Canyon watersheds; Township 12N, Ranges 09E, Sections 25 and 36; Township 12N, Ranges 10W, Sections 31 and 32; of U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) Quadrangle: Coloma; Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Project: The projects are limited to the installation of a permanent road crossing (C-22) over a Class I watercourse and the use of an existing water drafting site. The construction of Work Point C-22 consists of creating a rocked ford by removing an existing 16-inch concrete culvert and its associated fill in order to lower the road surface. Once the culvert is removed, clean rock (roughly sized 6-inch minus) will be placed as base for road surface. Over the top of that base layer, smaller rock will be placed to create a driving surface for the crossing. At the downstream side of the crossing, large 18-inch diameter rock will be placed to prevent erosion in the channel. If water is present in the crossing a temporary culvert, minimum 12 inches diameter, will be placed at the low point of the crossing and back filled with clean 6-inch rock to stabilize the culvert. A layer of clean ½-inch minus rock will be placed over the culvert as road running surface. Upon completion of operations, the temporary culvert and rock will be removed.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration /  timber harvesting plan prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures  were /  were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan  was /  was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
