Dear Mr. Cannon:

Thank you for including the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in the review process for the above-referenced project. The project involves the use of two existing warehouses for chassis depot, chassis storage and maintenance and repair. The larger of the two warehouses may be modified slightly with potential removal of approximately 20,000 square feet (sq. ft.) on the western side of the building. One of the driveways may need to be widened as well. The site is already currently paved and is secured with fencing and lighting.

The nearest State facility to the proposed project is SR-47. Caltrans does not expect project approval to result in a direct adverse impact to the existing State transportation facilities.

As a reminder, any transportation of heavy construction equipment and/or materials, which requires the use of oversized-transport vehicles on State highways will require a Caltrans transportation permit. Caltrans recommends that large size truck trips be limited to off-peak commute periods. In addition, any work performed within the State Right-of-Way will need an encroachment permit. For information on the Permit process, please contact Caltrans District 7 Office of Permit at (213) 897-3631.

Storm water run-off is a sensitive issue for Los Angeles and Ventura counties. Please be mindful that project needs to be designed to discharge clean run-off water, and storm water run-off is not permitted to discharge onto State highway facilities.
