**Project Location:** The Ontario Ranch Business Park Specific Plan (project site) encompasses eleven parcels totaling 85.6 acres in the City of Ontario. The City of Ontario is located approximately 40 miles east of downtown Los Angeles, 20 miles west of downtown San Bernardino, and 30 miles east from the Orange County line. Regional access to the project site is provided by State Route 83 (SR-83; Euclid Avenue), which connects to State Route 60 (SR-60) and Interstate 10 (I-10) to the north, I-15 approximately 5.5 miles to the east, and State Route 71 (SR-71) approximately 3 miles to the southwest. SR-71 connects the project to Interstate 91 (I-91) in unincorporated Riverside County.

The project site is located in the southwestern portion of Ontario, immediately north of the City of Chino in San Bernardino County, east of Euclid Avenue, north of Merrill Avenue, west of the unimproved right-of-way of Sultana Avenue, and south of Eucalyptus Avenue.

**Project Description:** The proposed project consists of a General Plan Amendment, Specific Plan, Development Plan Review, Tentative Parcel Maps, and a Development Agreement to allow for the development of an industrial and business park encompassing eleven parcels totaling 85.6 acres in the City of Ontario. The development proposes eight warehouse buildings ranging from 46,900 square feet to 618,353 square feet, totaling a maximum development of 1,905,027 square feet of warehouse and office uses. Office uses are ancillary to the warehouses and occupy up to 236,000 square feet spread across the eight buildings.
