Project Title: Monterey State Route 1 Culvert Repair Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0236-R4)

Project Location: The Project involves the armoring of one culvert that channels surface water in an unnamed ephemeral stream to the Pacific Ocean in Monterey County. The single culvert crosses under State Route 1, approximately 1.56 miles northwest of the unincorporated community of Lucia within Section 7, Township 22 South, Range 04 East, Mount Diablo Baseline and Meridian and can be located on the *Lopez Point, California* 7.5-minute quadrangle United States Geological Survey topographic map. The Project is centered near latitude 36.030031/longitude -121.574395.

Project Description: The Project involves the armoring of an existing corrugated metal pipe culvert and the in-kind replacement of the existing steel flared end section at the culvert inlet.
