PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) as the responsible agency will be issuing a water supply permit. West Valley Water District proposes to add an existing ion exchange system for Well 41. The treatment system was supposed to use at Well 49 but Well 49 was never constructed.
