PROJECT TITLE: Maintenance-of-Way Yard Development

LOCATION: California State Railroad Museum

COUNTY: Sacramento

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Create a new equipment maintenance yard at the California State Railroad Museum to allow for the storage and maintenance of railroad maintenance-of-way equipment. The project will:

- Grade to level an approximately 9,500 square foot area for the new equipment yard and roadway approach. Grading excavations will not exceed 14" in depth;
- Approximately 50' west of their current location, excavate an approximately 15' x 15' x 8' deep area and move all underground utilities (water, electrical and compressed air);
- Excavate a 12" wide by 2' deep by 20' long trench and install a drain inlet;
- Pour and compact a 5" deep layer of ¾" aggregate base in the excavation area for both the equipment yard and the approach; and
- Install approximately 9,500 square feet of 3" deep roller compacted asphalt in the equipment yard and the attached roadway approach over railroad tracks.

A State archaeologist will monitor all work.
