Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed an amendment to Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0285-R5, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Department of Parks and Recreation, City of Los Angeles.

The Project is limited to the complete eradication of Floating primrose-willow (*Ludwigia peploides*) from 45.4 acres of Machado Lake – Ken Malloy Regional Park. Floating primrose-willow is an invasive nonnative species. An additional .07 acres of Floating primrose-willow has been identified for removal. Currently, 1.15 acres of Floating primrose-willow has been identified within Machado Lake. Vegetation removal will not impact mitigation lands adjacent to the proposed project site [see Lake or Streambed Alteration (LSA) Agreement 1600-2007-0463-R5]. This project is also authorized and referenced under LSA Agreement 1600-2018-0222-R5.
