**Project Title:** Evan Hewes Highway Bridge Over Coyote Wash (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0118-R6)

**Project Location (include county):** The project is located at Coyote Wash, tributary to the Salton Sea, on the Evan Hewes Highway about 3.4 miles northeast of the City of Ocotillo, in the County of Imperial, State of California; Latitude 32.75797<sup>o</sup> N, Longitude 115.94036<sup>o</sup> W. Section 21, Township 16 South, Range 10 East, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Painted Gorge, San Bernardino Meridian.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0118-R6, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the Imperial County Department of Public Works.

The project is limited to the repair of the existing bridge to remediate structural deficiencies. Repairs will include: the repair of eight existing pier caps, pressure grouting and steel jacket encasement of 33 existing columns, repairs to existing columns/piles, addition of 36 new stringers, and repair of damaged concrete pedestal on an abutment.
