Thank you for including the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in the Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) and Traffic Impact Analysis (TIA) review process for Lakeside Equestrian Center project located on the northeast corner of Willow Road and Moreno Avenue, just east of State Route 67 (SR-67) in Lakeside. The mission of Caltrans is to provide a safe, sustainable, integrated and efficient transportation system to enhance California's economy and livability. The Local Development-Intergovernmental Review (LD-IGR) Program reviews land use projects and plans to ensure consistency with our mission and state planning priorities.

Caltrans has the following comments:

- 1. The submitted synchro analysis does not include the correct existing signal timings for the Willow Road nor Mapleview Street intersections with SR-67.
- 2. The submitted synchro analysis does not have the correct speed for SR-67.
- 3. Caltrans entered the existing signal timings and corrected the speed along SR-67 at both intersections and found significant direct impacts that will require mitigation at the following intersections:
  - a. The intersection delay difference between the Existing PM and the Existing PM+Project conditions for SR-67 & Willow Road is 1.0 sec.
  - b. The intersection delay difference between the Existing and the Existing AM+Project condition for SR-67 & Mapleview Street is 1.1 sec.

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- 4. A significant direct impact per County of San Diego's thresholds were also found for the same intersections as above and the following:
  - a. The intersection delay difference between the Existing AM and the Existing AM+Project condition for Maine Avenue & Mapleview Street is 1.2 sec.
  - b. The intersection delay difference between the Existing PM and the Existing PM+Project conditions for Maine Avenue & Mapleview Street is 2.5 sec.
