
**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0393-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Matthew Bissell representing RedDoon, LLC

The projects are limited to the permanent culvert replacements at Map Points R4, R5, R8, R9 and R11 and the drafting of water at Map Points R7 and R11, as denoted in the approved 1-18-00179 SCR "Meyley" Timber Harvest Plan.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 5/2/2019 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
