Attachment 1 – Project Description

The Modified Project consists of minor changes to the Canyon Del Rey (CDR)/State Route (SR) 218 segment of the Original Project. The Modified Project would be located within the environmental study area analyzed in the certified Final EIR for the Original Project, but with portions of the alignment that would extend outside the original footprint by a few feet. The CDR/SR 218 segment would extend from Fremont Boulevard at Canyon Del Rey/SR 218 through Work Memorial Park, continuing along the trail near Del Rey Park with a tunnel under SR218 where the Trail continues northeast up Carlton Drive to Plumas Avenue, and following along Plumas Avenue to terminate at Noche Buena Street.
