PROJECT LOCATION – COUNTY/CITY: The project site is located within the right-of-way of Jensen Avenue, between Fig Avenue and Fruit Avenue, at the border of Fresno County and the City of Fresno.

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT: Reconstruct the roadway within the project limits; upgrade or install ADA-compliant curb; widen the south side of Jensen Avenue by approximately 5 feet; install bike lane on the north side of Jensen and a combined shoulder/bike lane on the south side. Existing signs and utilities may be relocated.

REASONS WHY THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT: There will be no increase in the number of vehicular through lanes. Repairs made to the pavement will extend the life of the roadway and increase safety. New bike facilities will be installed along the north and south. Construction will occur in compliance with Caltrans regulations, related to lead and asbestos which might be present in paint, pavement, or soil.
