Biological Avoidance Measures:

1. Prior to construction, if construction activities are proposed to occur during the typical nesting season (February 15 to September 1) within potential nesting habitat within the project area, a nesting bird survey shall be conducted by a qualified biologist at least two weeks prior to construction to determine presence/absence of nesting birds within the project area. Work activities shall be avoided within 150 ft. of active birds, until a qualified biologist has determined that young birds have fledged and left the nest. Readily visible exclusion zones shall be established in area where nests must be avoided. USFWS and CDFW shall be contacted for additional guidance if nesting birds are observed within or near boundaries of the project site. Active nests shall not be disturbed and eggs, or young of birds covered by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA) and California Fish and Wildlife Code shall not be killed, injured, or harassed at any time.

Staging Areas Equipment and Material Storage: To avoid impacts to adjacent native vegetation and wildlife, all staging and equipment and material storage areas shall occur in existing pullouts or at currently paved locations. No vegetation clearing

on public or private land is allowed to create storage sites without first being cleared through Caltrans.

Visual Measures:

3. To minimize visual impacts of the exposed down drain portion, the replacement pipe will be painted flat black.

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
