The California Highway Patrol (CHP), Yreka Area, was recently requested to review environmental impact documents related to the proposed Lower Moffett Creek Bridge replacement project, located on State Route 3, from post miles (PM) 38.0 to PM 38.6, in Siskiyou County.

The CHP services and has primary jurisdiction for traffic enforcement in the unincorporated area of Siskiyou County and on State Route 3, within the proposed project location. Primary law enforcement services would be provided by the Siskiyou County Sheriff's Office.

While not opposed to the proposed bridge replacement project, after reviewing the Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND), CHP Yreka Area requests additional information regarding the "full detour on an adjacent county road," referred to in the document. Specifically, we request the opportunity to review the proposed detour route to ensure it is sufficient to meet traffic demands from State Route 3 and is acceptable for public safety, including timely passage of emergency vehicles through the detour.
