The project does not involve a federal Clean Water Act permit; waste discharge requirements under Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act; individual take permit; streambed alteration permit; or removal of specific required or native trees. For these reasons, this project is statutorily exempt from CEQA under Pub. Res. Code § 21080.35. This project will involve the installation of an electric vehicle charger in a garage at a dairy farm in Marin County. The charger will serve electric vehicles.
