Project Title: Third Avenue Bridge LOP 209 Repair Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0077-R3)

Project Location: The project is located where an unnamed tributary to Hagen Creek flows through an existing concrete box culvert under 3rd Avenue, approximately 0.25 miles south of Blue Oak Lane, County of Napa, State of California.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0077-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Napa County Department of Public Works.

The purpose of the project is to remove the concrete headwall on the upstream side of the existing box culvert, which was damaged during the 2014 earthquake, and replace it with a reinforced concrete retaining wall of approximately the same dimensions as the existing concrete headwall. The retaining wall will be supported on 18-inch cast-in-drilled hole piles that will be dowelled to the existing culvert. Additionally, approximately 4 cubic yards of rock rip rap will be permanently removed from the streambank in order to drill the piles.

Person or Public Agency Carrying Out Project: Napa County Department of Public Works

Exempt Status:

Reasons why project is exempt: The project is exempt from CEQA because it includes the repair and replacement of an existing facility. The new retaining wall structure will be approximately the same dimensions and will achieve the same purpose as the existing concrete headwall structure.
