Project Location: Sacramento County, approximately 1,500 feet west of the Clay Station Road and Twin Cities Road intersection.

Project Description: SMUD contractors will inspect SMUD's high pressure natural gas pipeline. The proposed project consists of the following scope of work:

- 1. Install a 4-inch, temporary, dewatering well no more than 20 feet below ground surface.
- 2. Dig a 10-foot x 10-foot hole to expose the pipe location. The depth is expected to be no more than 11-feet, where at least 2-feet of space beneath the pipeline is exposed for inspection. Initial ground disturbance will be done by potholing with hand tools to safely locate the gas pipeline. Once the pipeline has been located all other work will be conducted with heavy equipment (e.g. backhoe, excavator).
- 3. Install shoring equipment within dig area.
- 4. Perform a visual inspection of the pipeline.
- 5. Remove shoring equipment. Equipment utilized as a form of prop or support (e.g. aluminum plates and shores), usually temporary, that is used during the excavations to prevent collapse of the excavated area.
- 6. Backfill hole with cement slurry sand 18-inches above pipeline and native soil to preexisting conditions.
- 7. Workers will be provided environmental awareness training in advance of the work. It is not anticipated that any resources will be disturbed during the work activities.
- 8. Work is expected to begin in June and July of 2019 and will occur for approximately one to two weeks.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt:

CEQA Guidelines, Section 15301 states that "Class 1 consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use." This project may involve the repair or maintenance of a public utility natural gas pipeline involving no expansion. Section 15302 states that "Class 2 consists of replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced..." This project may involve replacing an existing section in the same location along SMUD's gas pipeline and will not increase the capacity of the pipeline. Section 15306 states that "Class 6 consists of basic data collection, research, experimental management, and resource evaluation activities which do not result in a serious or major disturbance to an environmental resource." This project involves due diligence to further inspect and collect information following a recent inline inspection of SMUD's natural gas pipeline. Section 15309 states that "Class 9 consists of activities limited entirely to inspections, to check for performance of an operation, or quality, health, or safety of a project, including related activities such as inspection for possible mislabeling, misrepresentation, or adulteration of products." This project involves the inspection of SMUD's natural gas pipeline to verify proper and safe operation of the facility.
