Project Title: Upper Zayante Creek Stream Wood Enhancement Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0104-R3)

Project Location: The project is located at Upper Zayante Creek a tributary to Zayante Creek and the San Lorenzo River, in the County of Santa Cruz, State of California; Latitude 37.106, Longitude -122.022 or Section 36, Township 9, Range 2W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Felton, Section 31, Township 9, Range 1W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Felton, Section 30, Township 9, Range 1W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Felton; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 074-011-03, 074-012-07, 093-041-01, and 093-041-10.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0104-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the Resource Conservation District of Santa Cruz County.

The proposed project will install approximately 20 large woody debris structures (LWD). The LWD wood will be locally harvested and consist of the removal of approximately 16 trees.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on July 24, 2019 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
