Terrestrial facilities (i.e. landing pipes, manholes, ocean ground beds, terrestrial cables, conduits, and an existing power feed equipment [PFE] facility) and marine components (i.e. marine conduits, marine cables, and cable regenerators) would be installed. An onshore landing site would be installed at either 6th Street or 10th Street to connect marine cables to a terrestrial conduit system and lead to an existing PFE facility.
