## PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

<u>Eastside Community Park - Phase One</u>: Phase One will contain community gardens, open park space, picnic areas and shelters, par fitness course, spray park, children's play areas with equipment, restrooms, seating and benches, a detention/irrigation lake, bio-swales, parking lot, multi-use fields (convertible - four baseball or one soccer based upon demand), bus stop and shelter, and associated park infrastructure such as lighting and walkways, and maintenance buildings. Resolution of the Planning Commission Recommending Approval by the City Council of the following items:

- a) Initiation of the Annexation of the park site,
- b) Pre-zone the park site as Open Space (O),
