Description of Project: The purpose of the project is to stabilize a 40-foot section of the bank of the Trinity River to prevent erosion around, and damage to, an existing domestic seep well. The project entails excavating and laying back the slope of the existing streambank; placing 20 cubic yards of riprap and five cubic yards of clean, washed drain rock; and planting native riparian vegetation up- and down-stream of the well.
