This letter provides confirmation that the proposed Lavender & Olive property was included in a County-approved cultural resources survey for the larger Copper Meadows property in October 2014. The 2014 archaeological survey tasks completed were in accordance with the County of San Diego Guidelines for Determining Significance and Report Format and Requirements for Cultural Resources, the County Resource Protection Ordinance (RPO), and Section 21083.2 of the Public Resources Code (CEQA) and 15064.5 of the CEQA Guidelines. Completed tasks included record searches with the South Coastal Information Center (SCIC), archival research, a review of historic maps of the property, Native American consultation (conducted by County planning staff), a field survey undertaken by County approved archaeologist and Native American monitor, and preparation of a letter report on the findings (Letter to Donna Beddow regarding Copper Meadows Equestrian Eventing Facility Administrative Permit (Tier 3): Cultural Resource Survey, prepared by Sue A. Wade, December 15, 2014). As a result of that survey, no cultural resources were discovered on the current Lavender & Olive property.
