<u>Project Description</u>: Extraction of sand and gravel reserves along Lower Cache Creek on 264.1 acres of a 319.3-acre site, with other project-related uses occurring on the remaining 55.2 acres. Mining of a maximum of 35,400,000 tons (30,000,000 tons sold) of aggregate resources (sand and gravel) over a 30-year period at an annual rate not to exceed a maximum of 2,117,648 tons mined per year (1,800,000 tons sold).
