Project Title: Penny Newman Wharf Repair and Reconstruction (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0020-R3)

Project Location: The project is located at the San Joaquin River, in the County of San Joaquin, State of California; Latitude 37°57'3.26"N, Longitude -121°19'2.19"W; Section 7S, Township 1N, Range 6E; U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Stockton West; adjacent to 1805 Harbor Street, Stockton, CA 95203; Assessor's Parcel Number 145-02-005.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0020-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Penny Newman Grain Company.

The project is limited to removal of five existing breasting dolphins (including 156 14-inch diameter timber support piles) and replacement with five (5) new breasting dolphins (each consisting of a single 60-inch or smaller hollow core steel monopole with a cone fender system). Also included is removal of the existing timber west gangway and west walkway and replacement with a new aluminum west gangway and west walkway. Additionally, 17 existing 12-inch diameter timber piles supporting the west walkway will be removed. A new abutment will be installed above mean higher high water.
