Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0131-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Santa Cruz County Department of Public Works.

Along the southbound lane of Lompico Road, a slip out, approximately 100 linear feet, occurred. The proposed project will make repairs to the road and stabilize the road from further erosion.


