**Project Description:** (please use a separate page if necessary)

The California Department of Transportation proposes a roadway rehabilitation project on State Route 99 from 0.2 mile south of the El Dorado Street overcrossing to the Clinton Avenue overcrossing (between post mile 21.2 and post mile 24.4) in Fresno County. The project would remove the existing lanes and shoulders and replace them with continuously reinforced concrete pavement. Between the start of the project, post mile 21.2, and just south of the McKinley Avenue undercrossing, the project would widen the median to 46 feet. Between the McKinley Avenue undercrossing to post mile 24.4, the project would widen the median to 22 feet. The project would construct new auxiliary lanes on the northbound and southbound side of State Route 99 within the Caltrans existing right-of-way. Auxiliary lanes would be constructed between: Stanislaus ramps and the State Route 99/State Route 180 junction and Olive Avenue ramp (one auxiliary lane on the southbound direction and two auxiliary lanes on the northbound direction which tapers to one auxiliary lane just south of Belmont Avenue overcrossing and it would continue onto the Olive Avenue ramp), and Olive Avenue ramps and Clinton Avenue ramps. The auxiliary lanes would be constructed within the Caltrans right-of-way.
