NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, August 17, 2021**, starting at **6:30 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the Joint Chambers, 1010 10th Street, Basement Level, Modesto, California, to consider the following:

PLANNING COMMISSION'S RECOMMENDATION OF APPROVAL FOR <u>GENERAL</u> <u>PLAN AMENDMENT AND REZONE APPLICATION NO. PLN2019-0079 – CAL</u> <u>SIERRA FINANCIAL, INC.</u> – Request to amend the General Plan and zoning designation of a 9.6 acre site, from Commercial and Salida Community Plan General Commercial (SCP-2) to Planned Development, to allow for development of a convenience store/community market, gas station, restaurant, retail building, and ministorage facility to be developed on approximately four acres. The project site is located on Pirrone Road, on the east side of the Pirrone Road and Hammett Road intersection, east of Highway 99, in the Community of Salida.
