Project Location: The Project is located along Permanente Creek, near the intersection of Charleston Road and Rengstorff Avenue, in the City of Mountain View, in the County of Santa Clara, State of California; Latitude 37.421323, Longitude -122.086655; Section 9, Township 6S, Range 2W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Mountain View; Assessor's Parcel Number 116-05-070.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0336-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, City of Mountain View.

The project is limited to the installation of a trash capture boom with two anchor bolts in the concrete bank. The trash boom will be a floatation structure used to collect floatable debris and trash. The boom will be composed of approximately 5-foot lengths of 6-inch diameter floatable foam sections wrapped in polyvinyl-coated fabric. The fabric wrap will also form a 12-inch skirt below the foam sections, providing sufficient draft to prevent trash from passing beneath the boom. The skirt will be ballasted with a galvanized steel chain that will connect to anchor plates at each end to provide bottom tension.
