Project Location: The project is approximately 6 miles feet east of Fort Bragg, along Forest Road 350, which connects from State Highway 20 to the South Fork Noyo River, in the County of Mendocino, State of California; Sections 24 and 25, Township 18N, Range 17W and Section 30 Township 18 N, Range 16W; Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian, in the Noyo Hill, Calif. U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0206-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection, represented by Erik Wahl.

The project is limited to seven encroachments. It replaces seven culverts along Road 350 with culverts that are sized to pass 100-year flow events and that are aligned and placed according to current standards. Channels may be defined up to twenty feet upstream of the inlet, and energy dissipating rock may be added at the outlet as necessary.
