Project Title: Carbonero Creek Building Protection Work (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0119-R3)

Project Location: The project is located at Carbonera Creek a tributary to Branciforte Creek, in the County of Santa Cruz, State of California; Latitude 37° 02' 58.0" N, Longitude 122° 00' 49.8" W (Degrees/Minutes/Seconds) or 340 El Pueblo Road, Scotts Valley, CA 95066; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 22-011-17.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0119-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Carbonero Creek Associates/Idevco.

The proposed Project will re-install displaced A-jacks. The A-jacks were originally installed to stabilize approximately 20 feet of Carbonera Creek's eastern streambank and was covered under Agreement #1600-2014-0333-R3. The project will also install boulders and cobble into the failed streambank to increase stability.
