**Project Location:** The project is on two parcels adjacent to the intersection of Bridgeway and Coloma Street in the City of Sausalito, Marin County, at latitude 37.868197 and longitude - 122.502530.

**Brief Project Description:** The Sausalito-Marín City Sanitary District would demolish both the Scotties and Whiskey Springs pump stations and replace both with a new Coloma pump station. The goal of the proposed project is to increase the reliability of the wastewater conveyance system and provide sufficient capacity to convey peak wet weather flows. The new Coloma pump station would contain a wet well with four submersible pumps, and underground valve vault, an underground flow meter vault, an underground electrical building, and three concrete pads for electrical equipment.

**Describe clearly why the project has no effect on fish and wildlife:** The project location is previously disturbed and in an area of high urban activity, and the project would involve minimal removal of trees and other ornamental vegetation. Based on the analysis presented in the Initial Study, the following justifications for a no effect determination are provided:

1. The project would not result in or have the potential to result in harm, harassment, or take of any fish and/or wildlife species.
2. The project would not result in or have the potential to result in direct or indirect destruction, ground disturbance, or other modification of any habitat that may support fish and/or wildlife species.
3. The project would not result in or have the potential to result in the removal of vegetation with potential to support wildlife.
4. The project would not result in or have the potential to result in noise, vibration, dust, light, pollution, or an alteration in water quality that may affect fish and/or wildlife directly or from a distance.
5. The project would not result in or have the potential to result in any interference with the movement of any fish and/or wildlife species.


**Determination:** Based on a review of the Project as proposed, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife has determined that for purposes of the assessment of CEQA filing fees [F&G Code 711.4(c)] the project has no potential effect on fish, wildlife and habitat and the project as
