The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (Department) has reviewed the Tribal Environmental Evaluation (TEE) for the above-referenced project (Project). The Department's review of this Project is pursuant to our role as the State's trustee and responsible agency for fish and wildlife resources under the California Environmental Quality Act, California Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq. The Project "would involve the new construction, remodeling and operation of an expanded casino adding an additional 61,931 square feet to the existing casino, new beverage and food areas, and a new 19,426 square-foot conference facility, and renovating lodging and guest rooms on the Paskenta Indian Reservation...". No impacts to biological resources are anticipated as the construction will be done within an already existing parking lot. Based on the description of the Project in the TEE, the Department has no comment. If the Project description changes in any way or additional biological resource information becomes available, the Department should be notified and provided an opportunity to offer comments regarding the updated information.
