OC Waste & Recycling is proposing to construct and operate a 437 ton per day green waste composting operation called the Bee Canyon Greenery at the active FRB Landfill, which is located at 11002 Bee Canyon Access Road, Irvine. The composting operation will be located on a 30-acre area of the landfill that is completely disturbed. The proposed composting operation will allow the County and incorporated cities to divert green waste materials from landfill disposal, in compliance with recent State mandates.

Please identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

The proposed Bee Canyon Greenery composting operation will result in the construction of eight 14.5-foot high water tanks to supply water to the composting operation. While these water tanks will not be visible to nearby residents, the water tanks will be partially visible from a community park. Mitigation for this significant impact will be provided by ensuring that the water tanks are painted tan or a similar color to blend in with the adjacent topography and hillsides. With the incorporation of this mitigation measure, no significant aesthetics impacts will occur. The Mitigated Negative Declaration/Initial Study did not identify any other significant environmental impacts associated with the project.
